They are self-propelled free on rail operation and are used for bridge-works, general civil engineering works, track works and general lifting duties. Used in tandem, they can lift and move 18 metre long track panels.

Machines used in private siding are designed to a lesser specification but still maintain the highest of integrity associated with a Cowans Sheldon cranes and associated equipment.

All machines are equipped with the latest electronic safe load indicator systems providing overload protection.

The latest engine management, hydraulic and electrical drive systems, and considerations for maintainability are incorporated.

With the vast experience of designing and manufacturing rail cranes, we continually strive to ensure our machines fulfil the expectations of our clients.
