JOB DESCRIPTION

Responsible to the Loading Supervisor, this post will be based at the Beeston Depot but will be required to work at various locations in the UK. The work will involve following S&C distribution units in the region and being available when the unit is operational or loading the units in a depot, therefore the role will involve working unsocial hours and in all types of climate.

Working as a member of a team of operatives, the Loader/Operator will be required to operate Network Rail owned and approved wagons/equipment within the depot and possessions and have knowledge of railway operational systems and associated equipment. Duties will include but will not be limited to:

- Undertake wagon preparation activities with a team, effectively and efficiently, to ensure efficient loading of the assets and components;
- Perform all preparation and loading activities in accordance with pre-determined client standards of quality and performance, implementing remedial action when requested;
- Receive deliveries of railway track panels and components;
- Ensure equipment used for wagon preparation is correctly maintained and in calibration;
- Ensure all operational reports and fault details are reported appropriately;
- Must be willing to undertake short training courses/modules in associated subjects;

Carry out any other duties within your capability as directed by the Supervisor.
